- IV. **Coaches Reports:**
 - A. Girls Tennis – Sara – 8 girls are returning from 2010. 9 of the 12 are underclassmen with 1 senior. They are a great bunch of girls.
 - B. Girls Volleyball – Paige – They are scrimmaging Webb on Friday, September 2. The goal of the team is to finish first or second in league. Junior Carly De Hoog verbally committed to the University of Washington recently, a top NCAA girls' volleyball program. Paige is proposing a better support system in which parents of all the OC sports teams come out and cheer for each other.
 - C. Cross Country – David reporting – The Big Bear camp was excellent. There are currently 13 runners on each team.
 - D. Football – David reporting – Since there were less athletes out for JV football this year, freshmen were needed to fill the JV roster. Thus, the freshman football schedule was decreased by a few games with a possibility of dropping more as the season progresses.

 - A. Gary Zondervan reported the following financial status:

 - C. The members discussed the possibility of getting a better return on our cash as the return on the money market account seems so miniscule. Gary and Terry will investigate our options.
- VII. **Athletic Directors' Reports:**
 - A. David Parkes reported all the fall sports teams are in full practice as they prepare for their upcoming seasons.
 - B. The Athletic Department requested \$3,500 from the Boosters for additional chain link fencing north of the stadium bleachers to allow for additional parking. Motion made and supported to approve the request. Passed.
 - C. The members discussed potential projects which the club could financially support.

- A. **2011-12 Athletic Program and Directory:** The deadline for advertisements to be placed in the souvenir program is next Monday, August 29. There has been an excellent response from advertisers with many companies advertising in both books. The cheerleaders and majorettes solicited several patrons for their pages. The program is coming together nicely with an outstanding net income expected.

- E. **Christmas Tree Sales:** The club agreed to sell Christmas trees once again. Bernie will contact the company and begin organizing the fundraiser.
