Minutes of the October 25, 2010, Meeting

1. **Meeting Called to Order and Opening Prayer:** Connie Leyva

4. **September Meeting Minutes:** Approved.
5. **Treasurer's Report:** Gary Zondervan reported a balance of \$26,522.07 in the Booster checking account and \$31,684.10 in the money market account. He reported that to date we have received \$31,635.00 in revenue from the Boosters sports program booklet and our expenses were \$14,543.75. Gross sales for the book and directory are anticipated to be \$56,695 so \$25,060 is still outstanding.
6. **Athletic Book Update:** Thank you Aurora Jubilee and Cheryl Beal for distributing books at the Ontario Christian Middle School and thank you to Kim Olvera and Bernie Gabrielse for working to get the books sent out to the various patrons and advertisers and for billing those who have yet to pay.
7. **Christmas Tree Sales:** Thank you David Parkes for helping us advertise the Christmas tree sales at the Harvest Festival. Bernie Gabrielse is working on flyer for distribution and has secured a two week ad in the Chino Champion. Connie and David will work with June Fakkema to put an ad in the next addition of the OC Knightline.
8. **Golf Tournament:** Connie will get a sample fundraising letter to everyone in November so we can start early with company sponsorships. Starting in January, the golf committee will start meeting bi-weekly at the Leyva's house. Everyone present felt that Wednesday nights would be a good night.
9. **Athletic Directors Report:** The members present decided that we would postpone our vote on approving funds for the Automated Timing System until the November meeting. Larry Vanden Berge gave a description of the system and its capabilities.

David Parkes reported that the new baseball field was coming along nicely and that the backstop netting was up. David also reported:

- a. Varsity Girls Volleyball is currently in 3rd place in the 8 team Ambassador League, junior varsity is undefeated in league play and the freshman team is also doing well.
- b. The Girls Tennis team is young this year and will finish in the bottom half of the league standings. The Ambassador League Finals start this Saturday at Cal Baptist University.
- c. Boys Cross Country is in 3rd place in the Ambassador League standings and should proceed to the CIF Prelims. First place Woodcrest Christian is the number one boys' team in the state rankings for its school size.

10. Football Report: Head Coach Laing Stevens reported the players are working hard and putting forth a lot of effort but their season has been challenging. They have a current record of 1-6 but if they win the 3 remaining league games, they could go to the CIF Playoffs. The junior varsity team is doing well. They have a current league record of 2-0 and could win league again this year. The freshman team has a record of 3-4.

11. Girls Cross Country Report: Head Coach Len Fakkema reported the girls have an overall record of 12-4 and are in second place in league behind Aquinas. The team is young with 2 freshmen, 4 sophomores and 1 senior. Six of the seven varsity girls ran their personal best in the Mt. SAC Invitational last Friday.

12. New Business: Laura Smith reported that she will be heading up the Boosters Bin. Laura and Aurora Jubile recently organized the Bin and Aurora and others sold merchandise at the Harvest Festival. Crystal Landreth organized a group of moms to work the Bin during the varsity football games.

The members present decided we should establish a committee to order new merchandise for the Bin. It was further decided we should have a "blow out" sale of the current merchandise. Connie appointed the following members to the committee: Laura Smith, Aurora Jubile, Jamie McMath, Brent Westra, Joe Molamphy, and Al Leyva. New designs will be approved by David Parkes.
