- IV. Coaches Reports:**
  - A. Cross Country – David reporting – The teams had a dual meet at Chaffey today. The boys squad is talented and hopes to challenge for first in league. The girls team now has 27 runners, probably the largest team in the school’s history. The top runners from both teams will be travelling to Washington this weekend for our every three year trip to run in the Silver Lake Invitational.
  - B. Cheer – no report.
  - C. Football – David reporting – The varsity is 2-1-1 with the Valley Christian rivalry game up next. Junior varsity is 1-2 and the freshmen have won their two games.
  - D. Girls Tennis – David reporting – The team is 2-5 with the first league match vs Aquinas today. Although the team is young, there is talent and good team chemistry.
  - E. Girls Volleyball – David reporting – The varsity is 2-1 L, 4-3 O with a match at Linfield Christian today. Big home matches against traditional league powers Arrowhead Christian and Calvary Murrieta are coming up.

  - A. Mike Fischer reported on middle school athletics. We are competing in league in varsity and JV flag football and varsity and JV girls volleyball and will be running at the Ambassador League cross country meets. The middle school facilities are in excellent condition and the middle school appreciates the use of the high school gym.
  - B. David reported the chain link fencing north of the stadium bleachers is in place and has worked very well for additional parking.
- VIII. Fundraisers:**
  - A. **2011-12 Athletic Program and Directory:**

1. The program was critiqued for future improvements. Some ideas: put in a middle school page, list the league members, list the advertisers by category in the index.

3. The directory could gross \$17,828 and the program \$50,275 for a total gross income of \$68,103. \$40,373 has been received to date and \$13,000 paid to the graphic designer for the fall program.
