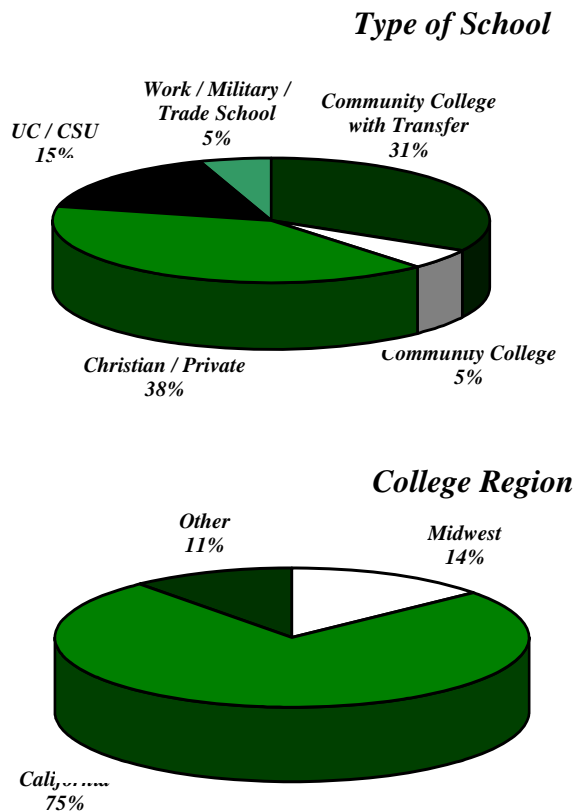
School and Community

Graduation Requirements

Students are required to complete 235 credits of course work for graduation. Each class is given 5 credits per semester. The core curriculum consists of 40 credits of English, 40 credits of Social Science, 30 credits of Math, 20 credits of Laboratory Science, 10 credits of Fine Arts, 5 credits of Vocational Arts, 5 credits of Computers, 20 credits of Physical Education/Health, 20 credits of Religious Studies and 45 credits of electives. Though no credits are required for foreign language, students are encouraged to complete the 30 credits recommended for admission to the University of California system.



Honors and AP courses are offered beginning in the junior year with Honors English 11 and AP U.S. History. Honors and AP courses offered to seniors are Honors Economics, AP English 12, AP American Government, AP Biology and AP Calculus.

Ontario Christian High School Curriculum

All classes meet approximately 50 minutes of every school day. Each class is worth 5 units of credit per semester if passed with a grade of D (60%) or higher.

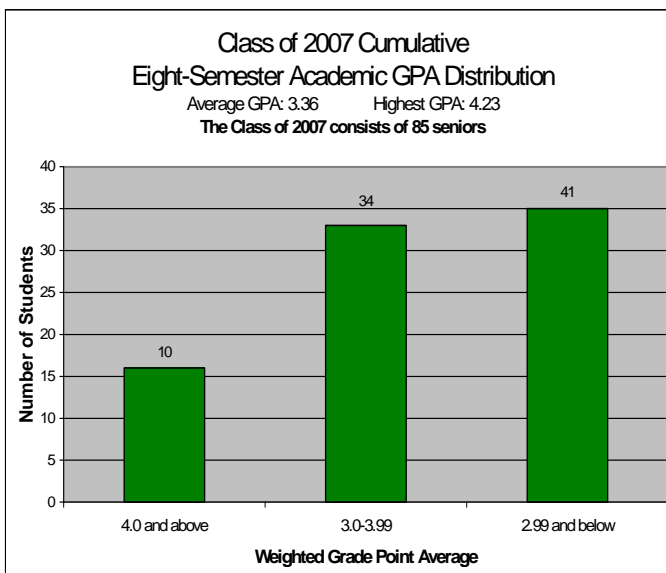
