5. **Coaches Report:**
 - Boys Soccer** – No report.
 - Girls Soccer** – Dave Belden reported there were 11-12 girls from the middle school that showed interest in high school soccer he would like to see about 40 come out. He had 6 seniors this year.
 - Boys Track and Field** – Jon Schaap reported Slater Ezell broke a school record and placed 2nd in CIF Division 4. Zach Oliver also qualified for CIF in the 2 mile. Much of the talent of this team will return next year.
 - Girls Track and Field** - Len Fakkema reported the girls won league. The 4x100m Relay team ran at the CIF Finals and placed 7th in Division 4 and broke the school record. Len is looking forward to 32 returners next year. This year was a great group and they had a great year.

They will be attending a camp at Laurel Pines Christian Center and they will be training in the pool and at 8,000 feet elevation. Cross Country will also be participating in the Mt. Baker Invitational in Washington state with the top 7 athletes entering.

8. **High School Athletic Director's Report:** David Parkes reported that things are going well and Spring Sports unfortunately are over. Len Fakkema and Jon Schaap received Coach of the Year honors for Track and Field. Kevin Knutson received Coach of the Year honors for Golf. David presented a proposal for football equipment with a total cost of \$1688 plus shipping and handling. Joe Knight moved to accept the proposal and Becky Knight seconded. Passed.
9. **Middle School Athletic Directors Report:** Dave Belden reported that there were no spring sports at the middle school this year. Next year there will be softball, baseball and track in the spring. On June 19th there will be a Christian Middle School League vote to accept our middle school into the league. The Middle School has a need for a softball field and a baseball field. Ted Terpstra has volunteered to move the backstops to a usable location once building construction is complete.
10. **Golf Tournament** – Mike Mendoza went the extra mile on donations. Early estimates show the Golf Tournament will net approximately \$7,000 to \$10,000. We will look into running it ourselves next year. The tournament was well organized and a good learning experience. Overall, many compliments were given and the golfers had fun.
