4. **Coaches report:**
 - Track** -- Jon Schaap reported that both teams were league champions, Girls 12-0 and Boys 11-1. League finals will be at the University of Redlands on Friday at 6:45 p.m. First place winners go to CIF and second place winners must meet a CIF qualifying mark.
