Registration Form and General Information

Our desire is to provide a safe and fun environment for you and your child. We request that your child is able to follow simple directions given and be able to dress themselves from their summer camp clothing, into their bathing suit without assistance. **Club IMPACT** requires that Camp T-shirts are worn daily. It is also important to know that The Ontario Christian Schools - **Club IMPACT** has **zero tolerance for any type of aggressive behavior.** **Please be sure to read and sign our Club IMPACT'S Policy for Summer Camp for K to 6th Grade.**

The following information will help you in planning each day according to our summer schedule. It is also important that you stay informed on a day-to-day basis. Please be sure to read the boards daily for ***News Updates, Parent Information, and Calendar of Events***. Please note that dates and times are subject to change. Please be on time, if you miss the bus, we will not meet the parents at the gate. Please stay in-touch and read the calendar of events for departure and arrival times.

OCS provides transportation for all fieldtrips.

Club IMPACT request that each child is checked-in by a parent or guardian, or your child will not be able to participate on that days' fieldtrip.

***Club IMPACT** will also offer an "on Campus Summer Camp" this year to those who want to attend Part-time, or remain at school on fieldstrip days.

Camp Uniforms:

SUMMER T-SHIRTS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES, NO EXCEPTIONS. You may purchase extra t-shirts for \$12.00 each. Summer T-shirts must be worn everyday; or you will be asked to take your child home if they forget their shirt. No short shorts, skirts, or dresses allowed. Summer T-shirts must be worn at all times. Bathing Suits for girls: conservative style, no 2 piece suits allowed. Boys swim trunks, no rivets or metal hooks. No high sandals, shoes must be worn at all times.

Personal belongings:

Please send a backpack or small bag to store their clothing, beach towel, and other personal items. We request that you limit the type of electronics your child brings to camp. **Please limit the amount of money you give your child.** We will not be responsible for any lost electronics or stolen money.

Sun-block, Water, and Snacks

Help your child by providing sun-block, extra water and additional snack items for your child during the week.

***Cell Phones:**

Your child is able to bring a cell phone for **emergency purposes only.** Phones will be taken away if your child abuses this privilege.

***Restricted Items:**

No iPods, MP3 players, CD player are allowed. These items will be taken away.

Dates and times to remember:

Summer registration beginning April 2, 2010, to all OCS students who are currently enrolled at OCS, in grades K-6 only. Registration space is limited. **Our camp hours are from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday thru Friday.** We close at 6:00 sharp, and a late pick-up charge of \$5.00 per every 5 minutes or any part of will be applied starting at 6:01 pm. This charge must be paid at the time of pick-up. If you know that you are going to be late, please call 909.983.1010, extension 300, informing us that you made arrangements for your child to be picked up by someone authorized on your emergency card. Excessive late pick-ups will result in losing your privilege in attending our summer camp program

Our summer program begins June 21, 2010 and ends August 27, 2010. You may choose any number of days or weeks that you want your child to attend. Also, on field trip days you may decide to have your child participate on that day's field trip, or remain on campus.

Summer Camp tuition is due on the 1st Monday of every billing week, or a late fee of \$25.00 will be applied to all late payments if not paid by Tuesday of each billing week. Part-time tuition is due on the same day you attend OCS Summer Camp.

Summer Camp Tuition Fee Only:

- **Full-time Summer Camp tuition:** \$125.00 per week. A \$125.00 deposit is required.
- **Field trips are optional,** the cost of field trips and meal vouchers are not included in the summer camp tuition
- **Part-time / Drop-in Summer Camp tuition:** \$30.00 per day, plus the cost of field trips and meal vouchers. \$150.00 deposit is required. **An hourly rate is available. Please call the director for details.**

Field Trips & Meal Tickets:

Field trips are scheduled once a week. Please complete and return the Summer Camp Pre-Order form, along with your summer registration form. **In order to secure your child's place, you must have all of your field trip fees and meal vouchers paid in full by May 31, 2010.**

There will be no refunds for field trips.

All ticket sales are final. We will not be able to refund or credit tuition due to sickness or absences due to any reason. No changes of schedules are allowed without a two weeks written notice to Mr. Miranda.

Arrival and Departure Procedures:

Club IMPACT opens at 7:00 am and closes promptly at 6:00 pm. Upon your arrival and departure you must sign-in or out your child on our school computer system. For those parents who opt to be on the hourly rate, your time is measured according to your arrival and departure times. If you forget to clock-in or out, you will be automatically be charged for a full day.

Club IMPACT'S Discipline Policy for Club IMPACT Summer Camp:

Club IMPACT Summer Camp Safety and conduct policies and procedures reference OCS Student Handbook. We will be using a 3-strike system this summer. Each child is given **ONE VERBAL WARNING** regarding inappropriate behavior while they attend our Summer Camp. Please refer to the white board for information regarding daily behavior.

1st strike: A letter from the student to parents explaining their behavior. Must be signed and returned the following day.

2nd Strike: He/she will not be able to attend the next major field trip.

3rd Strike - your child will not be able to attend Club IMPACT Summer Camp due to their disruptive behavior. **No credits or refunds will be given for disciplinary reasons.**

2. 1st strike – letter from student to parents regarding behavior. Must be signed and returned the following day.
3. 2nd Strike – will be unable to attend the next major field trip.
4. 3rd Strike - your child will not be able to attend Club IMPACT Summer Camp due to their disruptive behavior.
5. No credits or refunds will be given for disciplinary reasons.
