

On-Campus Summer School 2018 Course Descriptions

Academic/Required Courses: *Courses that students need to take for graduation requirements or college admissions requirements.*

Enrichment Courses: *Courses for our middle school and upper elementary students that allow them to explore new avenues or build skills and concepts.*

Course	Descriptions	Credit	Instructor
Reformed Bible Doctrine	This Bible course is required to graduate and covers the basic doctrines of the Christian faith from the Christian Reformed perspective. Taking this course enables students to lighten the academic load for their junior year. (Incoming 10 through grade 12)	5	Mr. Juarez
Computer Application	This graduation requirement on campus course will cover how to create documents, spreadsheets, and presentations with Microsoft Office and Google Drive. Additionally, the course will cover good and efficient use of the internet, printer functions, and some basic graphic design functions. (Incoming 9 through grade 12)	5	Mr. Brocco
English 9 or 10	This is a credit recovery course only for students that need to repeat one semester of English 9 or English 10. Counselor approval is required. Students will rigorously repeat key concepts in English 9/10 to work towards mastery of skills including: reading various genres of literature, improving critical analysis skills, vocabulary, and writing techniques. Students should expect a minimum of 1-2 hours of homework a night. (Incoming 10 through grade 12)	5	Ms. Stutz
Christian Leadership	Christian Leadership is a required course usually taken during sophomore year. Coursework focuses on the themes of identity, purpose, servanthood, and leadership as modeled by Jesus and taught throughout scripture. Students will examine these concepts through scripture study, book study, discussion, and through reflective, narrative, and expository writing. At the culmination of the course, students create a digital portfolio that illustrates his/her learning, growth, and faith journey. (Incoming 10 through grade 12)	5	Ms. Mendoza
